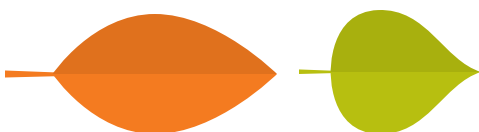
We hope your PTSA and service organizations will keep Thanks for Giving in mind during planning this summer. More in-depth information will follow in August.

Start planning

Will your food drive have a theme? Can you encourage a competition between classes or grade levels?



On your mark

Try coordinating your drive with Halloween, and be sure to advertise! Send out email and PTSA blasts, and encourage student participation with morning announcements and other appropriate activities.



Food pickup

CFR will have a team of volunteers going to each participating school to pick up their donated items. All you have to do is collect!



Thanksgiving Day

You and your students can feel good knowing families across Cobb County – maybe even their own classmates – are having a home-cooked Thanksgiving meal.



Set your goals

Decide reasonable collection goals and determine appropriate incentives for giving. CFR will begin distributing supplies, including flyers and posters, to all participating schools.



Collection time

Two weeks is a great length of time for a successful food drive: long enough to meet your gathering goals, and short enough to keep everyone's attention.



Distribution days

Your collected items will be boxed and distributed to up to 1,000 Cobb County families in need. This is also a great opportunity for students needing volunteer hours (ages 14+ only, please).
