NASHETA'S STORY

In July 2013, Nasheta Rice arrived in Cobb County to take a better job and create a better life for her two small children. Four months later, "it was clear that the job was not working out." Going back to her small Florida hometown was not a practical option; she had exhausted her savings in the move and there would be no work if she did return.

With little food in the house, she and her children faced hunger and homelessness. "I was pushing hard to look for a job and using all the resources that we could find." Referred to the Center for Family Resources by United Way, Nasheta applied for help in December 2013.

After working through the intake process with guidance from Caseworker Teresa Johnston, the Center for Family Resources paid one month of the young family's rent, \$649. "The result was we were able to keep our place. We weren't evicted. From there, I was able to get a job and get back on my feet."

In early 2014, Nasheta landed an entry-level position at Comcast. Within months, she earned the first of two promotions.

Earlier this year Nasheta celebrated her fifth anniversary with Comcast. She now has three children, is engaged to be married, and is currently in the process of purchasing her own home. Today Nasheta and her family are not only self-sufficient, they are thriving.

Nasheta urges parents who find themselves in similar positions to be patient with themselves and never give in to despair. "Do what you really need to do for your family. Use the resources that are available."

"It can be a test, but your test will turn into a testimony."

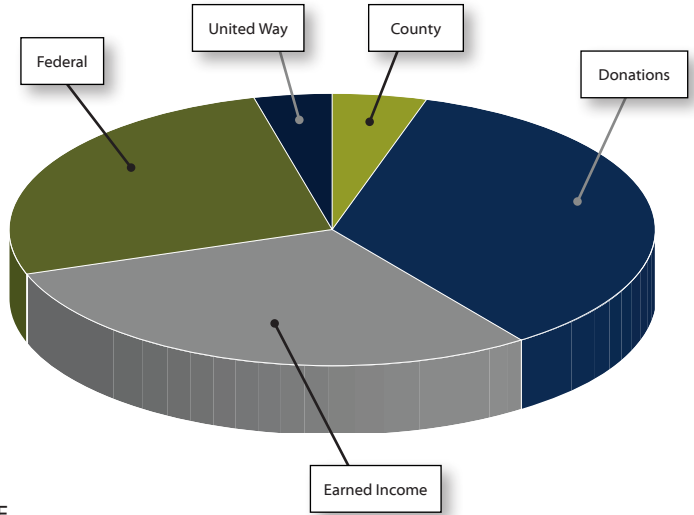

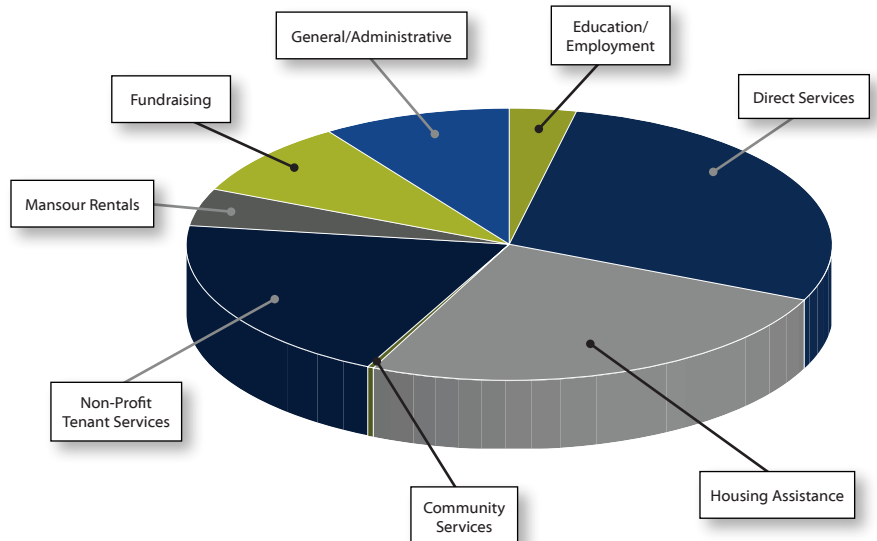
