OUR SERVICES

The Center for Family Resources is providing critical support to address the root causes of homelessness and housing instability. Our goal is to prevent and disrupt homelessness for children and their families in Cobb County. Poverty comes in many forms, with many different causes, and we do our best to address every aspect of the whole person to help build a better future. We believe that improving family stability enhances community stability. We support children and families through:

HOMELESS PREVENTION

Providing financial assistance for families at risk of becoming homeless while addressing challenges and helping them find stability through comprehensive case management. This includes help with food, prescriptions, transportation (bus tickets), and holiday programs.

HOUSING SERVICES

Offering both emergency short-term (60 day) and rapid re-housing programs for homeless families. Through intensive work with a case manager to create a housing plan along with supportive services that include assistance with childcare, employment, education, food, and life skills classes, with the goal to return to permanent, stable housing.



EMPLOYMENT & EDUCATION

Providing supportive services with the goal of increasing economic capacity through job readiness, employment training, financial counseling, budgeting, and life skills classes.
